CHIP TIMING

Route 66 10K offers chip timing provided by Final Lap Race Management with a disposable tag attached to your bib number. Your official time begins as you cross the start line and stops when you cross the finish line. If you do not wear your bib number during the race, you will not receive an official race time.

Results will be posted at the finish line area for participants to see their finish time & place immediately crossing the finish line.

Your registration has been added to Chronotrack Live so you may receive results notifications via text or social media immediately upon crossing the finish line.

RACE DAY PARKING

As the race starts and finishes within a block of each other in Downtown Edwardsville there are several parking lots within walking distance from the race.

Important Note: Parking is prohibited in the Park Plaza I & II parking lots (CVS, Glik's and Wasabi shopping centers) as well as the Walgreen's parking lot.

DURING THE RACE

Jogging strollers are permitted during our race, but participants using same must sign an additional waiver at packet pickup as inclusion of strollers in races increases the potential for injury to race participants and children. Be advised portions of the course are brick paved, and we ask that those with strollers queue behind runners at the start. Prohibited are children participating via scooter, skates, or on a bicycle.

The use of personal music devices are allowed at this race. To enjoy all that our race has to offer and for the safety of all participants, we encourage a headphone-free environment during the running of the Route 66 10K. Running headphone-free allows opportunities to develop camaraderie with your fellow runners and to enjoy everything the race has to offer. Plus, volunteers and spectators will be on course cheering you on and providing directions to help get you to the finish line.

No dogs are allowed with participants, with exception made for service animals. Runner safety has always been, and will continue to be, a top priority for our event. Thank you for your cooperation!

AWARDS

After racing we don't just award the overall winners with a medal, we give them the largest award plaque in the Metro East!! Overall road sign plaques are presented to Top 3 Overall and Top Master (40+) for both men and women. Age group custom medals will be presented 3-deep in all age divisions for both male and female categories.

This year the Route 66 10K has been selected as the RRCA State Championship 10K Race. Additional awards for Overall, Master, Grand Master & Senior Grand Master male and female will be awarded.

Awards Ceremony starts at 10:00am on the stage in City Park. Unclaimed age group awards will be mailed within 2 to 3 weeks after the event. In accordance with USATF Rules, age group awards will be determined by chip time and overall awards determined by gun time.

COURSE SUPPORT

Along the 10K course there will be five aid stations supplied with water Gatorade at the following locations:

- Mile 2.2: Water/Gatorade
- Mile 3.1: Water/Gatorade
- Mile 4.1: Water/Gatorade
- Mile 5.0: Water/Gatorade

FINISHER'S SWAG

All finishers will receive a finisher's multifunctional headwear (buff) in the finisher's chute.

Safe Sport Act

In accordance with the Safe Sport Act enacted by Congress in 2017, the Metro Milers and Route 66 10K have adopted the following policies:

NO one-on-one contact policy for anyone working with youth. Simply stated, if you see a child in distress (lost, injured, etc.) please ask another adult to assist you in helping said child.

Mandatory Abuse Reporting within 24 hours. Again, simply put, any reasonable suspicion of sexual misconduct should be reported to a race staff member or volunteer. This information will be reported to the local law enforcement.

GOSHEN TRIPLE CROWN CHALLENGE

Participants of Goshen Triple Crown Challenge will receive finishers medals after they have completed three races: the Bonifest 5K, the Route 66 10K and the Glen Carbon Covered Bridge 5 Mile runs. Special bibs will be given at each race. Medals will be handed out at the Covered Bridge 5 Mile on Saturday, June 15.

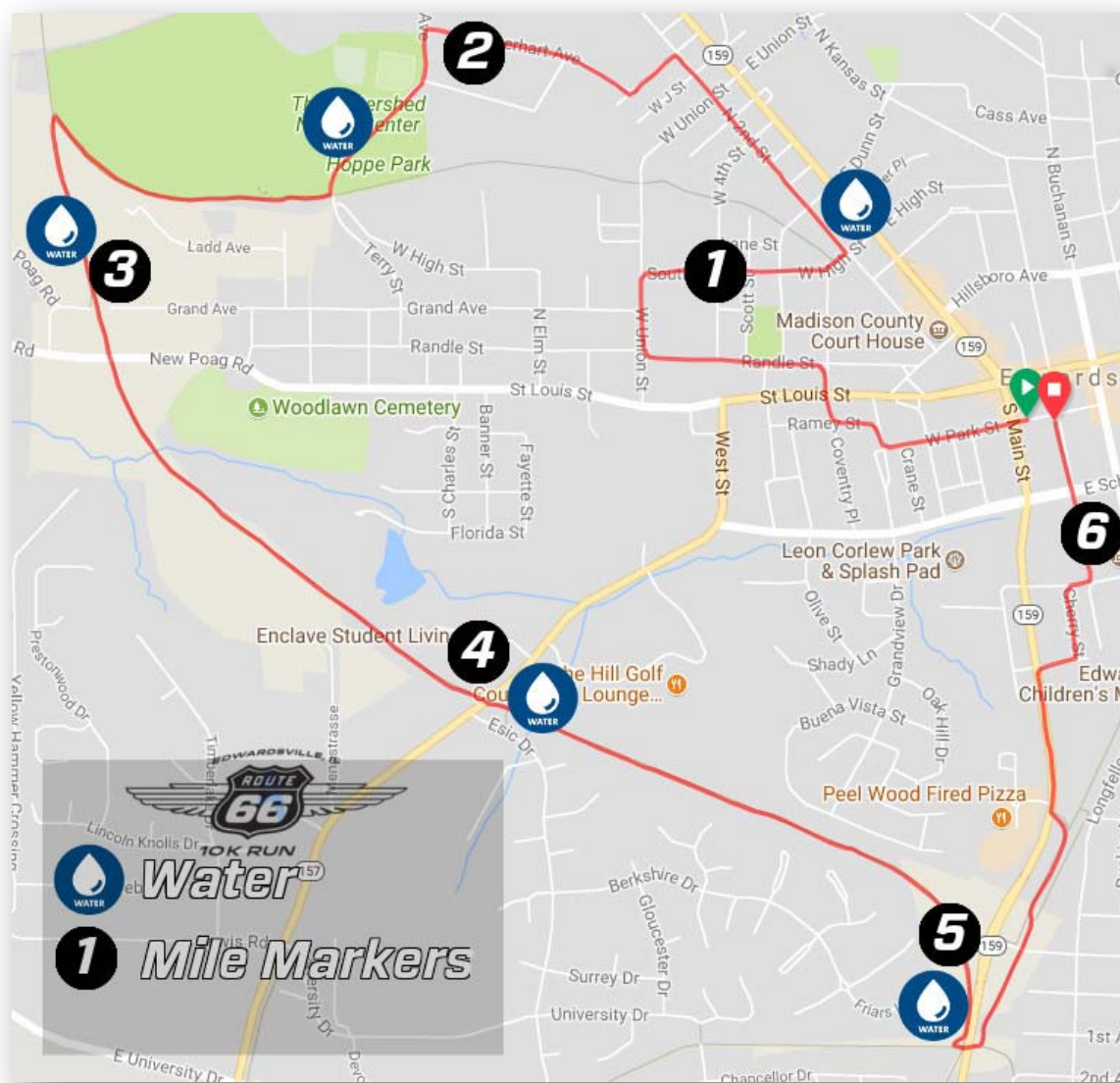
